

Increased investment in sports that supports grassroots cultivation of talents that will be competitive in global sports arenas.


Community-based development centres that are equipped with personal and career development coaches and that are open to all.

Sustainable exploitation of our human and natural resources that results in revenue for the nation beyond those generated from the sale of raw materials


Robust policies that encourage local production, attract foreign investment and incentivize all regions to look inwards for means of contributing value to the national purse

- This model is an adoption of the Igbo Apprenticeship System which has recently been described in the Harvard Business Review received a warm welcome globally


